INCOMING INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING [2019-2020]

Students from partner institutions studying abroad at Université de Nantes **can apply for on-campus housing** via the online application.



Attention ! The number of rooms available in university residences is limited and Université de Nantes is unable to guarantee housing for all international exchange students. To increase the chances of being placed in a university residence, students should apply as early as possible.

AVAILABLE ACCOMODATION IN NANTES AND SAINT-NAZAIRE	
ROOM TYPE	Single furnished room with private bathroom. A shared community kitchen is located on each floor. Students must purchase their own bedding and kitchen utensils.
ROOM DIMENSIONS	9m ²
MONTHLY RATE The rent includes water and electricity bills	254.80 €
SECURITY DEPOSIT required for check-in The security deposit is returned within two months of the student's moving out date if there aren't any damages assessed during check out.	270 €
HOUSING INSURANCE required for check-in Can be purchased online.	Between 40-60€ for the academic year
INTERNET ACCESS	WIFI is available in all residence halls



University residence halls in France are managed by CROUS - *Centre Régional des Œuvres Universitaires et Scolaires* - of each region.

Reservation periods are final and cannot be modified!

If a student decides to move out of his/her room before the end of the lease, he/she will be obligated to pay rent until the end of the lease.



You can request to **extend your accommodation period** for the 2nd semester or for the summer for **academic reasons only** and depending on room availability. More information will be available upon arrival in Nantes.

ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

There are many university residence halls in the city of Nantes, however, there isn't self-assignment. It is up to the International Relations Office's staff members to assign rooms depending on their availability.

Requests for changing assignments will not be taken into account.

Room Assignments Approvals

1 st semester or full year exchange students	Between June 15th-30th 2019
2 nd semester exchange students	Between December 10th-15th 2019



If you applied for university housing and you receive an assignment, **you will need to confirm it to make it definitive**. If you do not confirm, your room will be assigned to another student on the waiting list.

ARRIVING TO YOUR RESIDENCE AND CHECKING-IN

In order to check in to your dorm, you will need to have your housing **insurance certificate as well as your security deposit payment and the rent for the first month**.



In France, a French housing insurance is mandatory for everyone, including students. Once your mobility period has been confirmed, you will receive by e-mail your university residence assignment as well as a link to subscribe online to one of our housing insurance partner organizations.

Students are strongly recommended to **arrive during weekdays** Monday to Friday from 8:30am-12pm and 1:30pm-4pm. If you plan to **arrive outside these office hours**, you must inform the International Relations Office of your arrival date and hour as soon as possible in order for the residence hall to be informed and let you in.



You have to come to the Guichet Unique within the first days of your stay in Nantes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ✓ Monthly rent must be paid directly to the residence hall before the 10th of each month. Banking cards or cash is accepted.
- ✓ Students can purchase a **bedding kit** upon their arrival at the residence hall. The kit costs **27.26€** (2018-2019 rates) and it includes sheets, a blanket, a pillow and a pillowcase.
- ✓ Some residences offer disposable bedding kits only. This kit costs 15 €.
