*For students accepted in the **Double-Degree program**, a B2-level in English with a TOEIC score 785 will be required at the end of the 4th year in order to pass to the 5th year. If this English level is not reached, the student will not be able to pass the 5th year. That's why a B1-level in English is required for students applying for a Double-Degree program when integrating the 4th year of studies.*

Summer internship for the double degree programme

Be aware that the **additional summer internship** will be exclusively realized at the end of the 1st year of the double degree programme that is to say only between the 4th year and 5th year.

NIVEAU DE LANGUES

Le niveau B1 en français sera demandé à tous les étudiants à leur arrivée à l'ENIM.

Pour les étudiants acceptés en **Double-Diplôme**, le niveau B2 en anglais et un score de 785 minimum au TOEIC sera exigé en fin de 4^{ème} année pour un passage en 5^{ème} année. Si ce niveau d'anglais n'était pas atteint, l'étudiant ne pourrait pas passer en 5^{ème} année. C'est pour cette raison que nous exigeons au minimum un niveau B1 en anglais pour une candidature en double-diplôme et une intégration en 4^{ème} année d'études.

Stage d'été pour les étudiants en double diplôme

Ce stage est obligatoire pour tout étudiant inscrit en double diplôme. Il doit se dérouler uniquement en fin de la 1^{ère} année de double diplôme, c'est-à-dire à la fin de la 4^{ème} année d'études de l'ENIM.
