APPLICATION DEADLINE	<p>15 May for the autumn semester and academic year 15 October for the following spring semester Please contact directly ri.espe@univ-orleans.fr</p>
ARRIVAL	<p>It is highly recommended for students to arrive in France the week before the beginning of the semester to get settled and participate in the orientation days. Access to the student hall is limited during the weekend, so we advise to arrive on a weekday.</p>
ACCOMODATION	<p>After nomination, the International Office provides students with information to find accommodation in student residence halls. A monthly rent between 200 - 350€ is to be calculated as an average.</p>
HEALTH INSURANCE	<p>For international students coming to France, it is compulsory to have appropriate health insurance. Besides the European Health Card, a complementary health insurance is strongly recommended as well as medical repatriation.</p>
