## Physiotherapy Students

Each student will get an individual programme for the exchange period. However, the below mentioned orientations and Basics of Finnish course are compulsory.

Orientation to Clinical Practice in Health Care and Basics of Finnish courses are compulsory for all students, in order to do their clinical training within the Finnish health care system. These courses include lessons, practical skills labs, study visits and independent studies. The courses are planned to guarantee patient and student security in practice during the exchange.

During the clinical training, each student will have a personal mentor nurse who will guide student's learning. Students will follow mentor nurse's working hours. Please note that **students have all rotation hours, including weekends**. The student will also have a supervising lecturer from TAMK.

The students should bring working shoes and nametags. Clinical placements will provide uniforms for students.

It is possible for students to complete less ECTS credits than in the offered programme, but more credits is not possible to include in three months' exchange period. Students will work a full working week (40 hours) for which they are awarded 1,5 ECTS credits.
