<b>Class Registration</b>  <i>** registration in the Faculty of Law is done differently</i>	All registration in classes will be done via the Exchange Office <b>Semester 1</b> - registration occurs +/- first week of June (with some changes permitted up until the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of the semester). <b>Semester 2</b> - registration occurs at the start of November (with some changes permitted up until the 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of the semester).
<b>English Language requirements</b>	Classes are taught in English. Students need to have a level of English that is at least equal to (or better) than <b>IELTS 6.5</b> or <b>TOEFL-IBT 85</b>
