<p>Academic Calendar</p>	<p>The Academic Year is divided into two semesters: Winter Semester (September - February) Summer Semester (February - July).</p> <p>The exams of the first semester take place in January and February, the exams of the second semester take place in June and July.</p> <p>Italian Public Holidays</p> <p>January 1st/6th Easter Monday April 25th May 1st June 2nd (24th Florence's patron saint day) August 15th November 1st December 8th/25th/26th</p>

<p>Grading System</p>	<p>The Italian Grading System ranges from 18/30 to 30/30. The highest mark is 30/30 with distinction (lode). Exams under 18/30 are considered as "not passed" and cannot be registered on the final transcript of records.</p>
<p>Linguistic Center (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo – CLA)</p>	<p>Students have the opportunity to attend courses of languages at the University Linguistic Center.</p> <p>The first Italian course is free for Erasmus students.</p> <p>Preliminary enrolment for Italian language courses can be done online. <p>Nomination Deadlines</p>	<p>31/05/19 first semester/ all year 30/11/19 second semester via mail to: incoming@scienze.unifi.it</p>
<p>Application Deadlines</p>	<p>30/06/19 first semester/ all year 31/12/19 second semester via mail: incoming@scienze.unifi.it</p> <p>The necessary documentation for the application will be communicated to the student at the moment of the Nomination.</p>
<p>Registration in Florence</p>	<p>At their arrival students must end the registration process at the International Relations Office of the School of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences in viale Morgagni 40-44, Firenze (a photo passport size is needed). Student will receive a student card with their matricola number and the credentials for online services.</p>
<p>Transcript of Records</p>	<p>At the end of their mobility period students must go to the International Relations Office of the School of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences to return the student card and check the exams registered. The Transcript of Records will be sent to the home institution by mail. The original document will be sent by ordinary mail only on request.</p>

Accommodation	<p>The University of Florence does not provide any service for students' accommodation.</p> <p>Here there are some useful information: https://www.unifi.it/vp-10832-accommodation.html</p>
Visa	<p>Non EU students who want to study at our University need a residence permit.</p> <p>They have to present the request within 8 days from their arrival at the competent office: Questura di Firenze. The request must be presented at a postal office, where the applicant can obtain the necessary kit.</p> <p>EU students, who are going to stay in Italy for over a 3 months period, have to register with the Anagrafe (Register office) of the municipality of residence.</p> <p>For further information: https://studyinitaly.esteri.it/visa</p>
Health Care System	<p>Students with European medical card (EHIC in English/ TEAM in Italian) issued in the country of origin can access to Health Services, eventually with payment of a ticket.
