HOUSING	
The accommodation rooms, the canteen and the leisure spaces, found under the patrimony of DJUG are composed of 9 dormitories, 3 canteens-restaurants, a student chapel, 2 gyms and 1 medical center. All the facilities are located in 3 university campuses: "Alexandru Ioan Cuza", "22 Decembrie", "Științei". The Erasmus+ incoming students will be accommodated in the "22 Decembrie" campus, IA dorm. The price for a place in double room is, at this moment, 85 EUR/month (utilities included).	
IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS	
Study visa	NON-UE students wishing to study in Romania need to have a passport valid for at least six months longer than the expiry date of the student visa. Before travel students need to obtain a study visa from the Romanian Embassy/ Consulate in their home country. As visa regulations may change, please contact the nearest Romanian Embassy or Consulate in your country for the most up-to-date and detailed information. Student visas cannot be obtained in Romania.
