Greetings from Glasgow Caledonian University!

We are pleased to announce our dates for International Summer School. Our programmes on offer will allow students to experience life at university, while gaining credits.

Running for 2 weeks from Wednesday July 17th until Tuesday July 30th 2019 (with exception of Developing Nurse Led Services, where there is an option for a 3rd week until Tuesday August 7th)

Students can check into accommodation from Tuesday July 16th and Check out is Wednesday July 31st.

The target market for all courses as detailed below is undergraduate students (all levels), although Masters students are welcome to apply provided they are aware that the course is aimed at Bachelor level. Academic record will be required with application. Full application and course details are available on our website, URL at the end of this letter.

<u>2 week credit course (1.5 US credits / 2.5 ECTS)</u>

Global Finance	Entrepreneurship and the Circular Economy
Entrepreneurship and Innovation for Social Impact	Developing Nurse Led Services * also offered on a 3 week course

As a partner university the cost is £1050 GBP per student for the 2 week course. However, as an additional discount we can offer a 2 tuition free places (£625GBP – 2 week course) for every 5 students applying to our Summer School. Therefore for 7 students attending it would work out at around £925GBP per student.

The tuition fee as detailed above includes:

- On-campus accommodation
- Airport pick-up
- A range of social events and excursions, from city tours, to visiting the Scottish Highlands, and even a 'ceilidh' – traditional live music and dance event

We also have the following optional extras available:

- 5-day meal plan (75 GBP per week)
