The metropolis is an alpha global city—as listed by the GaWC—and is the most populous city in Brazil, the Americas, and the second most populous in the Southern Hemisphere. The municipality is also Earth's 12th largest city proper by population. The city is the capital of the homonymous state of São Paulo, Brazil's most populous and wealthiest state. It exerts strong international influence in commerce, finance, arts and entertainment. The name of the city honors Saint Paul of Tarsus. The city's metropolitan area of Greater São Paulo ranks as the most populous in Brazil and largest Portuguese-speaking city in the world.
