International Students general support	<p>The MPU incoming team will support the international students during the mobility period. There is also the Ambassador Program in which MPU students offer support for foreign students.</p> <p>Welcome Session: One week before the start of classes.</p>
Language support	<p>The Mackenzie Language Center (MLC) offers Portuguese language course for all exchange students. Depending on the agreement with the partner university, the course can be free of charge.</p>
Health insurance requirements	<p>An International Health Insurance is mandatory for all international students accepted by MPU.</p>
Accommodation	<p>There are many accommodation options within walking distance of the campus. Students can ask for more information contacting the MPU incoming team: incoming@mackenzie.br</p>
Visa information	<p>Depending on the level of education, foreign professors and students may apply for different types of Visas in Brazil. Information about our city	<p>São Paulo is a city located in the southeast region of Brazil. The metropolis is an alpha global city—as listed by the GaWC—and is the most populous city in Brazil, the Americas, and the second most populous in the Southern Hemisphere. The municipality is also Earth's 12th largest city proper by population. The city is the capital of the homonymous state of São Paulo, Brazil's most populous and wealthiest state. It exerts strong international influence in commerce, finance, arts and entertainment. The name of the city honors Saint Paul of Tarsus. The city's metropolitan area of Greater São Paulo ranks as the most populous in Brazil and largest Portuguese-speaking city in the world.</p>
