Application Deadlines ** early applications are encouraged	Complete applications for a September start (our 1 st semester) are due by April 15th (<u>sooner</u> is better) Complete applications for a January start (our 2 nd semester) are due by Oct. 15th
Class Registration ** registration in the Faculty of Law is done differently	All registration in classes will be done via the Exchange Office Semester 1 - registration occurs +/- first week of June (with some changes permitted up until the 2 nd week of the semester). Semester 2 - registration occurs at the start of November (with some changes permitted up until the 2 nd week of the semester).
English Language requirements	Classes are taught in English. Students need to have a level of English that is at least equal to (or better) than IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL-IBT 85
