Nomination Deadline	<p>15th June for Fall semester or full academic year</p> <p>15th October for Spring semester</p>
Application Procedure	<p>Once the student is nominated by the home university, we send the application form and the courses catalogue to her/him. The student is then asked to fill in the application and return it to: fac.droit.international@univ-catholyon.fr</p>
Application Deadline	<p>01st July for Fall semester and Full academic year</p> <p>01st November for Winter semester</p>
Academic Requirements for Admission to the Exchange Program	At the discretion of the home university
Semester Dates	<p>Fall semester: early September to 21st December /provisional, to be confirmed</p> <p>Winter semester: early of January – End of May</p>
Orientation Program	<p>Compulsory</p> <p>1st semester: early September</p> <p>2nd semester: early January</p>
