Academic Requirements for Admission to the Exchange Program	At the discretion of the home university
Semester Dates	Fall semester: early September to 21st December /provisional, to be confirmed Winter semester: early of January – End of May
Orientation Program	Compulsory 1st semester: early September 2nd semester: early January
