<p>Courses for exchange students</p>	<p>The courses offered at Ostfalia UAS are mainly taught in German. English taught programmes are:</p> <p>Faculty of Business offers a “International Academic Year”.</p> <p>In 2022 the Faculty of Law will offer a “International Business Law Semester” in English:</p> <p>The Faculty of Mechanical Engineering offers a few courses in English. Please ask our Incomings advisor.</p> <p>The Centre for Modern Languages (“Sprachenzentrum”) offers language courses (including German language courses). All courses are free of charge!</p>
<p>Language of instruction</p>	<p>Most of the undergraduate courses are taught in German.</p>
<p>Student accommodation</p>	<p>Rooms are available in the student residences or private houses.</p>
<p>Cost of living</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In the federal state of Lower Saxony students do not pay any tuition fees but a semester contribution. Exchange students have to pay a contribution about 280 € which covers the public transport and admin fees. - Housing deposit in the student residence: 400 € - Housing costs: 250 – 400 €/month - Student prices at Ostfalia: - Lunch 2 – 5 € - Coffee: 1€ - Sandwich: 1,50€ - Dinner in a restaurant: 10 – 35 € - Health insurance: about 90 €/month - TV licence: 17,50 €/month - Mobile phone: approx. 10 – 20 €/month - Students need approximately 800 €/month in total
