If you want to join us here in Florence as Erasmus student, you need to have a good knowledge of the language in which you wish to study: a **B1 level to study in ITALIAN and a B2 level to study in ENGLISH are required.**

Moreover, a basic knowledge of the ITALIAN language is recommended to enjoy the experience in Florence.

Courses

The academic year is divided into semesters. In each semester there are courses of 3, 6, 9 or 12 CFU (Crediti Formativi Universitari, 1 CFU = 1 ECTS).

Please bear in mind that a subject held in the first semester won't be repeated in the second semester. There are only a few courses offered all the year long.

As Erasmus student, you can choose subjects from any Bachelor's Degree (Laurea Triennale) or Master's Degree (Laurea Magistrale) you wish to.

It is advisable to **come nearly a week before the beginning of the semester** in order to enrol and to familiarize with Florence and the University.

Italian Language

The course of Italian language is not a subject of the School of Economics and Management; therefore, **it cannot be part of your Learning Agreement** or of your Transcript of Records and it doesn't give you mark or ECTS but only a certificate of attendance. Nevertheless, your University on the base of the certificate issued by *Centro Linguistico di Ateneo* - may give you ECTS depending on the level obtained.

It is a platform that matches the supply and demand of short stay accommodation in the private market.

Cost of living

The price to rent a single room here in Florence goes from 350 to 450 Euros per month while you can find a double room for approximately 250 Euros.

Students attending the School can get the canteen card to have meals for approximately 4,00 Euros.

The monthly bus ticket for students costs about 33,00 Euros.

According to the rules regarding the Erasmus+ program, incoming students are exempted from paying tuition fees at the University of Florence. However, the material cost of books, photocopies, certificates, etc. are borne by the student. Moreover, at the end of the Erasmus study period at our School, if students would like to have a personal certificate of the results (Transcript of Records), they'll have to pay an Italian tax of 16,00 Euros (so called "marca da bollo") otherwise, the certificate will be sent directly via email to their home University for free.



Enrolment

Due to the COVID emergency measures in place, the Enrolment procedure will be done by email, so there is no need to come to the office. You will be emailed by erasmusdesk-presnovoli@unifi.it which is the enrolment office for the Erasmus students and they'll explain you the enrolment procedure.

The International Relations Office of the School of Economics and Management is located in Via delle Pandette 32 (Novoli Campus, Building D1), 50127 Firenze and it is open every Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 10:00 to 12:30. How to reach the Novoli Campus and the School of Economics and Management? From the town center by **bus routes 57 and 23** and alternatively by the **Line T2 Tramvia** from the centre of Florence - Piazza Unità (near Santa Maria Novella) to Novoli, get off at the stop "San Donato Università".
