Language of Instruction:	Portuguese for undergraduate courses.	
Language Requirements:	Portuguese – recommended level B. NOTE: MPU offers a one-semester Portuguese course free of charge for incoming students from partner universities, based on the agreement.

Course enrollment/registration:	The students should arrive at MPU one week before the start of classes to attend the pre-enrolment meeting and the Welcome Session.	
GENERAL ASPECTS – INCOMING STUDENTS		
International Students general support:	The MPU incoming team will support the international students during the mobility period. There is also the Ambassador Program in which MPU students offer support for foreign students. Welcome Session: One week before the start of classes.	
Language support:	The Mackenzie Language Center (MLC) offers Portuguese language course for all exchange students. Depending on the agreement with the partner university, the course can be free of charge.	
Health insurance requirements:	An International Health Insurance is mandatory for all international students accepted by MPU.	
Accommodation:	There are many accommodation options within walking distance of the campus. Students can ask for more information contacting the MPU incoming team: <u>incoming@mackenzie.br</u>	
Visa information:	Depending on the level of education, foreign professors and students may apply for different types of Visas in Brazil. For undergraduate students, the type of visa to apply for is the Temporary Student Visa IV (VITEM 4).
