<p><b>E-nomination Deadline (Partners)</b></p>	<p>1st semester: from March 15 to April 30 2nd semester: from August 30 to September 30</p>
<p><b>E-nomination Process (Partners ONLY)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sign in to our online nomination portal (link sent by e-mail beginning of March and end of August)</li> <li>• Fill in the home university information</li> <li>• Fill in the nomination form as many times as necessary</li> <li>• Specify the courses (Cf. Above "Fields of studies" and "Languages") taken by each nominated student, <b>and</b> the necessary adjustments required (extra time, alternate exam conditions, etc)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Online Application Deadline (Students)</b></p>	<p>1st semester: from March 15 to May 30 2nd semester: from September 15 to October 18</p>
<p><b>Application Process (Students)</b></p>	<p>The International Officer of our faculty, send by e-mail, the <b>online application process directly to the nominated student.</b> The required documents are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• all academic transcripts of records</li> <li>• curriculum vitae</li> <li>• certificate on the ability of French (No official certification required, a letter from home university confirming B1 level of French must be provided)</li> <li>• cover letter</li> <li>• learning agreement signed by the 3 parts (Student, Responsible person at the sending institution and our Pedagogical Coordinator)</li> <li>• identity photo (will be used for student card)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Notification of Decision (Letter of Acceptance)</b></p>	<p>1st semester: until June 15 2nd semester: until November 15</p>
<p><b>Housing Application deadline</b></p>	<p>1st semester: usually until the last week of June 2nd semester: from October to November 13</p>

<b>Buddy System</b>	<p>Once selected, all students have the possibility to join our buddy system (link will be sent by e-mail). It's about connecting student-volunteers with incoming international students in order to provide the international students a helping hand before their arrival and also during their mobility.</p>
<b>Specific study needs</b>	<p><a href="#">Studies and exams adaptation</a> (EN)  <a href="#">Steps to follow</a> once arrived in Grenoble (FR)</p>
<b>Orientation Week -Mandatory-</b>	<p>1st semester: 1st week of September  2nd semester: 2nd week of January  Exact dates and activities will be sent by e-mail to selected students a month prior to arrival</p>
<b>Registration</b>	<p>1st semester: Between May and July  2nd semester: A month prior arrival  <b>Mandatory documents for registration:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Passport or ID</b></li> <li>• <b>Registration form</b> (provided by our faculty and sent by e-mail to the students)</li> </ul> <p><b>IMPORTANT:</b> the affiliation to the student social security is no longer part of the registration process at the university.  We strongly recommend to read the <a href="#">Health web page</a> to find out more.</p>
<b>French Courses</b>	<p>20 hours are offered to all students (3 ECTS if passed)  1st semester: during the Orientation week (September)  2nd semester: during the 2nd semester</p>
<b>Courses start date</b>	<p>1st semester: 2nd week of September  2nd semester: 3rd week of January</p>
<b>Courses end date</b>	<p>1st semester: 3rd week of December  2nd semester: 1st week of May</p>
<b>Exam Period</b>	<p>1st semester: 2nd to 3rd week of January  2nd semester: 1st to 3rd week of May</p>
<b>Re-sit Exams</b>	<p>1st semester: 2nd to 3rd week of June  2nd semester: 3rd week to last week of June</p>
