Application Deadlines <i>** early applications are encouraged</i>	Complete applications for a September start (our 1 st semester) are due by April 15th (<i>sooner is better</i>) Complete applications for a January start (our 2 nd semester) are due by Oct. 15th (<i>sooner is better</i>)
Class Registration	All registration in classes will be done via the Exchange Office Semester 1 - registration occurs +/- first week of June (with some changes permitted up until the 2 nd week of the semester). Semester 2 - registration occurs at the start of November (with some changes permitted up until the 2 nd week of the semester).
English Language requirements	Classes are taught in English. Students need to have a level of English that is at least equal to (or better) than IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL-IBT 85 or 115 Duolingo English Test (DET) .
