Practical information	
Visa	British and Non-European students must get a visa to study in France. In order to apply for a visa, students shall provide their current passport (valid for the duration of stay) and their acceptance letter.  If you live in one of the 44 countries subject to the "Études en France" ("Studies in France") procedure, you must first apply to enroll in a higher education institution through the platform "Études en France". Your visa application will be automatically sent to the "Campus France office" of your home country through the platform.  For example, the following countries are all using the "Studies in France" procedure: Argentina, Chile, China, Colombia, Lebanon, Mexico, Morocco, Russia, Senegal, South Korea, Taiwan and the United-States.  If you do not live in one of those countries and you need a visa to come and study in France, please contact the French consular authorities in your home country.  Some consulates ask for an IELTS or a TOEFL proving a B2 level in English. Please also contact the French consular authorities in your home country.
