	have an English B2 (IELTS 6.0) level. Leiden University of
	Applied Sciences does not require a language test but relies
	on its partner institutions to evaluate their student's English
	proficiency. The minimum level of English is specified in the
	exchange agreement between your home institution and UASL.
Grading system	Each course taught at LUAS is worth either 15 or 30 ECTS.
	One ECTS credit represents 28 hours of full-time study. The
	Dutch grading scale consists of numbers running from 1 to
	10, where 1 is the lowest grade, 10 the highest and 5,5 the
	lowest passing grade.
Documents and Transcripts	At the end of the students' exchange, any Erasmus
	documents (such as learning agreements, statements of
	attendance, etc.) and transcripts of records are taken care of
	by the programme with which they were registered as an
	exchange student. The International Office can only redirect
	you to them, so please contact the programme coordinator
	directly.
