Is there a pick-up service pro- vided upon arrival?	Yes. Exchange students are required to let us know well in advance when they'll be arriving in Wernigerode.
Is there support to find accom- modation for exchange stu- dents?	Yes. The International Office will organise accommodation in shared stu- dent dorms.
How much is student housing?	Approximately 300,- € per month.
Is there a Buddy programme?	Yes. All exchange students are automatically assigned a local buddy when their place is accepted. They will meet their buddies during the orienta- tion days.
Are there any compulsory addi- tional fees to be paid by stu- dents? If so, what fees?	Yes. The semester fee is approximately 120,- €. It covers administrative costs and a student ticket. And it entitles students to use all buses within Wernigerode and Halberstadt for free. Upon acceptance, every student will receive a payment request with all the necessary information. There are no tuition fees!
Do I need Health Insurance ?	 Yes. All students are required to have health insurance covering medical expenses: EU citizens have to bring their European Health Insurance card Non-EU citizens have to register with a public health insurance provider Further we recommend taking out a private liability insurance policy that covers the costs of damages
What are the visa-requirements for non-EU students?	Students who are not EU/EEA citizens should turn to their closest Ger- man embassy at least two months before the beginning of their studies to find out about the regulations. Please note that a national residence card of an EU member state does NOT automatically entitle students from non-EU countries to stay in Germany for study purposes.
