Exchange program proposals	In accordance with their home university, exchange students may propose a program combining both Bachelor's and Master's level courses/projects.
Student units accommodation with CROUS (students welfare organisation center)	Under our agreement with the CROUS housing department, ÉNSA Versailles provides available units in 3 CROUS university resi- dences (2 in Versailles and 1 at one station to Versailles) for ex- change students applying during the specified dates. Please note that we cannot guarantee housing applications managed by CROUS, as our limited quotas may not accommodate all requests.
