LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

The main language of instruction is French: https://ices.fr/nos-formations/

English courses are offered in the departments of English Language & Literature, Political Science (BA & MA Degrees) & Law (BA & MA Degrees).

A <u>free French language course</u> is offered to the international students (9 ECTS/semester). A one-to-one conversation course (Tution in French) is also offered for free and is worth 3 ECTS.

GRADING SYSTEM

French grading system is awarded on a scale from 0 to 20:

20 = highest mark

10 = pass mark

0 = lowest mark

ECTS credit system: 30 ECTS/semester. More information here.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Fall Semester runs from the end of August (welcome seminar included) to the end of December (exams session included)

Spring Semester runs from the first week of January (welcome seminar included) to mid May (exams session included)

Resit (for both semesters) mid-June

Nomination deadlines: June 15th (Fall semester) - October 15th (Spring semester)

Application deadlines: June 30th (Fall semester) - October 30th (Spring semester)

Holidays

Christmas break (two weeks in December & January) Winter break (one week in February or March) Easter break (one week in April) Summer break (July & August)





HOUSING INFORMATION

ICES does not provide on-campus residence.

Students may choose from one of the following options:

- Private flat: +/- 500€/month (utilities & meals excluded)
- Host family (only a few ones please contact the ICES IRO for more information & contact details)
- Residence "Escale Ouest": 360€/month all-inclusive except meals & administrative fees
- <u>Foyer La Louisiane</u> (females' residence managed by a non-profit association) : 550€/month utilities, breakfast & dinner included
- Residence La Simbrandière (CROUS) 310€ to 318€/month all-inclusive except meals

We encourage students to book their accommodation as soon as possible after receiving the admission letter.

HEALTH INSURANCE

European citizens must hold the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card).

Non-European citizens must register at the French Social Security (free of charge): https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/

Students holding one of the following card/form are exempted from this registration:

- European Health Insurance Card
- SE401Q102 or SE401Q106 forms (R.A.M.Q / Québec)

The French Social Security does not cover 100% of the medical bills so we encourage students to take a personal/travel insurance that covers the rest of the medical expenses.

BANK MATTER

Students living in Escale Ouest Residence must have a French bank account while in France. ICES IRO will assist students with the process.

Compulsory bank fees: 80€/year (credit card & room insurance fees).

Whatever the accommodation option, students are highly encouraged to secure a room insurance in case of any damages that might occur during their stay in France. For more information please contact the IRO.





HOW TO REACH LA ROCHE-SUR-YON

Most of the students land in Paris Charles-de-Gaulle Airport (CDG).

From CDG you may reach La Roche-sur-Yon either by train https://www.ouigo.com/ with a connection in Nantes train-station or you may take another flight to Nantes Airport (NTE) https://www.nantes.aeroport.fr/fr, then reach Nantes train-station and take a train to La Roche-sur-Yon.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The ICES Student Card may give access to some discount in town (shops, transportation, etc).
