Application Process

Nomination

Students have to be nominated by their home institution.

Nomination must be done through the *Mobility Online* platform. The link will be send by email.

Nomination deadline:

Spring semester: October 15



Online Application

Students will receive an email with a link to the application platform after being nominated by their home institution. Please always check your spam folder.

Application deadline:

Spring semester: October 31

During the application process, students have to **class by order of preference** their choice of campus among **Paris or Lyon.** The campus of Bordeaux has no offer for incoming students for the Spring semester.

Then they must choose between one of two tracks (management or marketing).

Application documents:

- Last transcript of records
- One portrait picture for the French student card
- English Language certificate (B2 CERL minimum)

All documents should be in PDF format, either in French or in English.

Every document must be uploaded on Mobility Online. No documents will be accepted via email.



Acceptance

Once the admission jury is over, students will be able to download their **admission letter** directly from Mobility Online.

We suggest that students wait for the official admission notice before making **any logistical decisions**.

You will be given the steps to choose your courses and complete the learning agreement **after** receiving the admission letter.


