## Academic

Academic year	<ul> <li>1<sup>st</sup> semester: Start of September – Start of February</li> <li>2<sup>nd</sup> semester: Start of February – June</li> <li>Welcome Day is organized the week before the start of 1<sup>st</sup> semester.</li> </ul>
General course requirements	<ul> <li>Students must: <ul> <li>Have completed three years of higher education (180 ECTS) by the start of the exchange period;</li> <li>Be enrolled as a regular student in a partner university of AgroparisTech;</li> <li>Fulfil course requirements (see course descriptions).</li> </ul> </li> <li>Exchange students may register for 30 ECTS credits (maximum) per semester. There is no minimum credits required. Students can attempt up to 60 ECTS credits per academic year.</li> </ul>
Language requirements	The minimal required level is <b>B1 both in French and English-taught programmes.</b> However, a <b>B2 level is recommended to follow courses and take exams</b> comfortably. Most courses at AgroParisTech are taught <b>in French.</b> We insist that the incoming exchange students should have a minimal knowledge of French to be able to attend classes and take exams. French courses free of charge are available during the academic year.
