### Credit System and Course Load

UCD uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). A full course load is 30 credits per semester. At undergraduate level most modules are worth 5 credits and students take six modules per semester.

Exchange students may take fewer modules if permitted by their home institution. Students from outside of Europe must take a minimum of 20 ECTS in order to meet their visa/residency requirements.

Modules at UCD are not guaranteed and are subject to capacity, availability and timetabling.

Restrictions apply in some subject areas, including:

- · Health and Agricultural Sciences
- Psychology
- · Politics and International Relations
- Business
- Law
- · English Literature & Creative Writing
- History
- Master's level classes (level 4)

Students will receive information about modules from their respective college before they arrive. UCD Global does not manage module registration. Students have a two-week period to add or drop modules from the first day of classes.

#### Results of Examinations

Examination results are released online a month and a half after the end of the examination period. All students may access their Statement of Results online and download a copy to forward to their home institution.

#### Language of instruction

All modules at UCD are taught in English – incoming students are advised to have a minimum level of B1 (CEFR).

Erasmus students are not required to provide proof of English language proficiency as part of their application.

Students coming from non-English speaking universities outside of Europe will need to show proof of English language proficiency. e.g. IELTS 6.5. Please see:

# 4 Immigration Requirements

#### Student Visa

Please be aware that students with citizenship of certain countries (including the US or Australia) do not require a student visa to enter Ireland but must register with the Irish Immigration Service Delivery (ISD) after arrival in Dublin.

and will be further explained at Orientation.

Students who need a student visa must contact their local Irish embassy for information as soon as possible about the visa application process.

Incoming students should email the incoming team to request supporting documentation.

**Important:** Visas valid for the UK and the Schengen countries are NOT valid for the Republic of Ireland.

#### Work

EU/EEA/UK citizens are free to take up employment in Ireland while studying.

Non-EU/EEA/UK citizens may be able to seek employment in Ireland depending on their immigration permission and duration of study. Trimester abroad students are not entitled to work in Ireland. Non-EU/EEA/UK citizens studying in Ireland for more than a single trimester of study can seek casual employment, meaning they can work for 20 hours per week during term time and full-time during fixed holiday periods.

The right to work lapses automatically on expiry of a student's immigration permission.

# Transportation from airport to UCD

#### Insurance
