## **Useful Information for Incoming Students**

Number / Area of ECTS credits:

- ECTS credits workload for semester: at least for 24,0 ECTS credits and not exceed 30,0 ECTS credits (for a full year of studies at the UA, ECTS workload should account at least for 48,0 ECTS credits and no more than 60,0 ECTS credits);
- For a full year mobility, the workload must be balanced between semesters;
- Course units directly associated with the field of study under which the application is submitted must account at least for half of the total ECTS workload in the proposed learning agreement.

Instructions to apply:

- Once we received our partner's nominations, we will send the instructions and procedures about applications directly to the nominated students, by email (after the 15<sup>th</sup> of April – for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and after the 1<sup>st</sup> of October, for the second semester);
- We will only accept applications containing a Learning Agreement complete, dully filled in and signed by the students and the home university.

Portuguese as Foreign Language (PLE):

- We provide Portuguese as Foreign Language (PLE) courses throughout each semester for 4 hours per week completely free of charge for exchange students and they are strongly recommended to include it;
- Each course unit accounts for 6,0 ECTS credits and is not considered in the maximum limit (that means a student can apply for 36,0 ECTS per semester (if including PFL course unit);
- Additional information about PFE course units, refer to <u>PLE</u>.
