Please note <u>our subjects are just theoretical</u>. There is no clinical practice included in the courses you choose. For instance: "508273 - BLOOD DISEASES – 5 credits" means you will attend 40 hours of theory (for the ECTS system, as to theoretical subjects, 1 credit is worth 8 hours)

At the moment (academic year 2020-21), all of the classes and exams are online There is a University portal you can access to attend lessons and take part in exams. Access is possible only with your University credentials

• Mobiliy Office (<u>incoming.erasmus@unipv.it</u>) who takes care of your enrolment, will provide you with credentials and instructions

As to the practical part:

The Clinical Rotations are named "Clinical Cases" and, due to Covid-19 emergency, they have been suspended since February 24th 2020. There is no news on the date they will restart and they can be replaced by online clinical cases solving, receiving a declaration of equivalence at the end of your stay (so, no one loses the practice-related credits).

What are "Clinical cases"?

Our students need to attend mandatory 16 practice weeks per year, 8 per semester, according to specific rules.

As in the ECTS system 1 credit corresponds to 25 hours, the clinical trainings are based on the equivalence between 1 ECTS credits and 1 week.

So, Erasmus students can choose up to 16 weeks per year, but also less according to the requirements of their Home University; it is not possible to ask for more.

Either Erasmus choose the Italian or the English Faculty, they will be put into English course groups, because English Faculty has 100 students per clinical year, while Italian has 200 and so there is fewer possibility to find places.

So, I kindly ask you to tell me how long you would need to attend the hospital (as if it were possible), which wards you require and how many credits you need to achieve (1 week = 1 ECTS credit).

Please note we can't – in any case - offer trainings in Thoracic surgery, Neurosurgery, Maxillofacial Surgery, Childhood Neuropsychiatry, Forensic Medicine, Plastic Surgery, Pallliative Care, Rehabilitation, Clinical Pharmacology.

LEARNING AGREEMENT MODEL – very important!!!!

You will have to complete a learning agreement draft and send it to us, because we need to work on it before defining the final version. If your University has its own form, you can use it, copying carefully our data from the attached form. Otherwise you can use directly the attached one. **Don't send us any signed pdf version of the learning agreement before receiving our**

confirmation on the draft.

How to fill the learning agreement:

- 1) if you take only a module, insert the code with MED/ and add in brackets the course it belongs to. For instance: MED/11 Cardiology (part of the course "Heart and Lungs")...
- 2) if you take a whole course, with all of its parts, insert the code starting with "5..." For instance: 506538 HEART & LUNGS
- 3) add the number of practice weeks in the wards without a specific order, below the list of subjects: I will divide them according to our organization
 - For instance:
 - 1 week Dermatology
 - 2 weeks Cardiology
 - And so on

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The University of Pavia recommends a B1 level of both English and Italian, but doesn't ask students to provide any language certificate while applying.

The English course offers lectures and exams in English, but the clinical practice is mostly in Italian, as there isn't a full time translation service in the hospital wards (it is not possible to attend the hospital at the moment). We advise students they'd better learn our language in order to have a better experience and imorove daily life too.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

The following part is the protocol that Fondazione Policlinico, the main University Hospital, requested to students until 2019-20, but at the moment it is suspended, so **it is just a provisional list of clinical examinations**, waiting for the Hospital to communicate the new requirements:

ONE MONTH BEFORE ARRIVAL (not before) the Hospital requires the following documents to let you attend the wards:

- work capacity certificate from a licensed occupational Physician, in English (a certificate assessing that you are able to attend a professionalizing internship in the field of Medicine)
 - any specific exam requested by occupational physician to do the certificate (not mandatory; only if The Physician attaches exams to the declaration)
- a recent Electrocardiogram
- certificate of all the vaccinations you have done so far, including Mantoux test (please use the form "Vaccinations for students and volunteers " - attached)-

All of the above documents need to be sent to the Hospital Direction (Dottor Simone Tezzon <u>S.Tezzon@smatteo.pv.it</u>) and to me in copy, writing in the text of the message: name, surname, mail address, date and place of birth, home address and telephone.

Students need to send Dr Tezzon the tax code too.

It can be sent after arrival, because it is obtained once in Pavia; you can find the requirement within the "Upon the Arrival" rules you will have to attend:
