Language of instruction	<ul> <li>Portuguese.</li> <li>In the most of the curricular units, students can do their evaluations in English and/or Spanish. Also, most of the teachers do follow up Erasmus students in those languages, either in classes, individual meetings or by e-mail. However, it should be noticed that there is always the risk that in some curricular units it is not possible to be supported and do the evaluations in other language than the Portuguese.</li> <li>Students are highly encouraged to do an OLS Portuguese course before arriving and to enrol in our Portuguese course do begin after arriving.</li> </ul>	
Language requirements	<ul> <li>Student Mobility for Studies: B1 in Portuguese or B2 in English or Spanish. A Certificate (OLS or other) will be asked.</li> <li>Staff Mobility for Teaching: C1 in Portuguese, English or Spanish.</li> </ul>	
Portuguese Language Intensive Course	<ul> <li>In each semester, GRI organises 2 or 3 Portuguese Language Intensive Courses (70 hours) for different levels (A1, A2 and/or B1).</li> <li>In the first class, students are assessed to determine in which level each one will be placed.</li> <li>The course has a fee.</li> <li>At its end, students receive a certificate.</li> </ul>	
Academic Year Structure	<ul> <li>Ist Term <i>Classes</i>: Beginning of September – End of January <i>Exams</i>: End of January – Mid February         <ul> <li>2nd Term <i>Classes</i>: Mid February – End of June <i>Exams</i>: Mid-June – Mid July</li> <li>Continuous evaluation takes place in at least three moments during the classes' terms. Students have to attend exams only when they do not obtain approval in continuous evaluation during classes.</li> </ul> </li> <li>It is highly recommended that students organise in order to be here until the Exams period.</li> <li>Vacations         <ul> <li>Latada: usually in end of October</li> <li>Christmas: 2 weeks</li> <li>Carnival: 2 days</li> <li>Easter: 1 week</li> <li>Queima das Fitas (an academic traditional festival): usually in the 2nd week of May</li> <li>Summer: August</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
