	months. This includes those who work, the self-employed, students, those
	intending to live off savings, retired people and family members of any of the above.
	First of all students have to go to International office of the IPVC to take
	Declaration for proving their status of non-European student, to take to the
	bank to open an account and to financial office to take fiscal number, finally
	to SEF.
	Necessary Documents
	When applying for a residency permit the following documents must be
	supplied:
	• Application Form
	Valid passport plus one photocopy
	• Two identical recent, color passport photos
	• Fiscal ID number
	• Declaration (which one you took from International office)
	• A fee (around 150 EUR for 1 year)
	The residence permit takes a few weeks to process and once issued bears the
	person's photograph and signature. Once the residency card has been issued it
	must be carried at all times for possible inspection.
	Temporary permits are valid for one year and are renewable for two-year
	periods. Applications to renew a permit must be sent 30 days before the expiry
	date.
