## **Procedures**



#### **Nomination**

Partner universities: Fill in a nomination form and submit it via Google Form during the above specified nomination period.





#### **Online Application**

Students: Submit application documents through the online application system during the above specified application period.

Refer to the <u>KUFS Website (Partner University Students)</u> for required application documents and application procedure.

[Note] The exchange period cannot be extended once the nomination has been accepted.

# **Entry Requirements**



### **GPA**

GPA of 2.5 or higher is preferred on a 4.0 scale \*Other requirements except below are as per the agreement.



## **Language Proficiency**

<ul> <li>Required to have studied the Japanese language for 150 hours or more.</li> <li>To be able to read and write Hiragana and Katakana.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Required to have equivalent to TOEFL iBT score of 62 or IELTS score of 5.0.</li> <li>Native English Speaking students are not required to have the English score.</li> </ul>

# **Visa Application**

Non-Japanese nationals who wish to study in Japan are required to have a 'student visa' for the duration of their exchange program.

After the application for the exchange program is officially accepted, KUFS will send an acceptance letter and a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) required for the visa application.

# **Insurance**

#### **National Health Insurance**

All international students residing in Japan for over 3 months are required to enroll in the Japanese Health Insurance.

Those students holding the Student Visa are required to pay approx. 18,000 yen per year.

# **KUFS-Owned Residence**

KUFS has three student residence managed by the KUFS Housing Support. The KUFS Housing Support will arrange accommodations on a first-come, first-serve basis. Rent must be paid per semester (min. 378,000 yen - max. 450,000 yen).

The details will be sent to you from the Housing Support after you have completed the application procedures.
