APPLICATION PROCESS

through which the exchange will be made.

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The first step to begin the process in UAG would be to send through the Study Abroad Office at the home university an email nominating the selected students containing the following information:

Please mention the agreement or association

- Full name
- Major
- Current semester
- Email
- Application period(s)

Once we receive this information, we will contact students directly through an email detailing the required documents, deadlines, as well as the general regulations, to apply to our program.

We will inform the results in the following ten days after receiving the student's documentation.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0

Since Spanish is our main language of instruction, we recommend having a B2 level of language proficiency. We would accept a certificate issued by the language department of the home university validating the student's language proficiency level.

UAG does not recommend an exchange to students on the final period of their program as we cannot assure the availability of the courses that will complete their academic needs.

VISA

Students from certain countries who wish to carry out their studies in Mexico for a period of less than 180 days do not require a student visa.
