




## **Campus Sint-Lucas Ghent**

APPLICATION PROCEDURE	Step 1 - Your home university should send your nomination via our nomination form (https://forms.office.com/pages/responsepage.aspx?id=m1hzOUCetU6ADrC2OD0WIeNQbsehfgBCvhaRor5H-uFUN0JMVDU2QVQ0TTdNOTcyRzYzVjgzRkNXMC4u&origin=lprLink&route=shorturl).  Step 2 - Complete the online application procedure. Please do not forget to upload the supporting documents:
	<ul> <li>Motivation letter in which you explain the choice for our programme.</li> <li>Proof of enrolment at the home institution - from which your current level of study can be deducted.</li> <li>Proof of language qualification. Students who do not have English as their native language are required to provide proof of good knowledge of the English language, both written and spoken (equivalent to B2 level). This may be a certificate issued by your local exchange coordinator.</li> <li>Learning agreement (OLA via EWP): signed by the applicant and the home university.</li> <li>Photocopy of the identity page of your passport or identity card.</li> <li>All documents should be uploaded in PDF format. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Only applications through our online system will be considered!</li> </ul>
APPLICATION DEADLINES	1st semester or full academic year: 30 April 2025 2nd semester: 1 October 2025  Once you are accepted as an exchange student, you will receive a letter of admission and information letter, allowing you to register as an exchange student. Late applications can be refused.
