Application	procedure
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- 1. Nomination by partner institution
- 2. Ostfalia gets directly in contact with the students and provides information and the link to the digital application form.
- 3. The following documents have to be uploaded then:

Vitae

- o Passport
- Passport FotoTranscript
- o Erasmus+ applicants: Learning agreement and EHIC
- o Accommodation form if the students opt for assistance
- o Proof of sufficient health insurance policy
- 4. Ostfalia provides an invitation letter or returns the signed Learning Agreement and stays in constant contact for any doubt the students might have
