Language of instruction	<p>The vast majority of the undergraduate courses are taught in German.</p>
Student accommodation	<p>Rooms are available in the student residences. International Student Office happily assists students to get a room.</p>
Cost of living	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In the federal state of Lower Saxony students do not pay any tuition fees but a semester contribution to the student union`s purposes of about 350 €. They will get the student ticket for public transportation e.g. - Housing deposit in the student residence: 400 € - Housing costs: 350 – 450 €/month - Ostfalia Cafeteria: Lunch 4 € - Quick Service Restaurants: Lunch 10–20 € - Coffee: 4 € - Sandwich: 3 €–5 € - Dinner in a restaurant: 15 – 40€ - Health insurance: about 125€/month - TV & radio license(mandatory): 19€/month - Mobile phone: approx. 10 – 25 €/month - Students need at least 950 €/month in total
