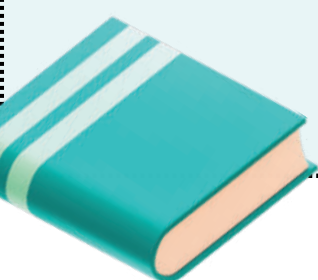

2. NOMINATION BY THE INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OFFICE (SENDING UNIVERSITY)

Autumn semester : from 2nd of March to 15th of May 2026

Spring semester : from 31st of August to 2nd of October 2026

Nomination by email should include : first name, last name, date of birth, nationality, length of stay (semester/year), department of study and ISCED code, level of study, E-mail address



3. STUDENT APPLICATION TO THE IUT

Autumn semester : from nomination to 1st of June 2025

Spring semester : from nomination to 15th of October 2025

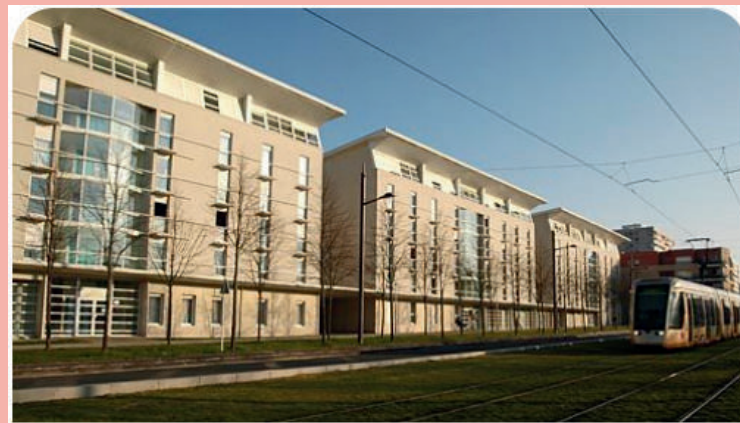


ACCOMMODATION
