<b>Nomination procedure</b>	The SNS International Office accepts incoming student nominations via email. <b>To submit your nominations, you will need to send us the following information:</b>  Full name of the student (as it appears on the passport, including middle names) Date of birth of the student(DD/MM/YYYY format) Email address of the student Level of study Field of study Period of study at SNS  <b>Optional:</b> if the students must obtain a minimum number of ECTS credits during the mobility period.
<b>Application procedure</b>	Nominated students will receive an email with a link to the SNS online application form. They will have to upload the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Photocopy of passport or ID document</li> <li>- ID photo</li> </ul>
<b>SNS Tutor</b>	Before their arrival, students must choose a Tutor among the SNS professors who will be their academic advisor during the mobility period.
<b>Course Catalogue</b>	The course catalogue is published in July. Students may prepare their choice of courses based on the current year's catalogue, published on the website: <a href="#">Didactic offer</a>
<b>Grading system and credits</b>	The number of ECTS recognised at the end of each course is specified on the SNS website within each course sheet. At the end of their stay, students will receive a Transcript of Records with the list of all activities. Individual student's subjects are graded on a scale from 1 to 30, with 18 and 30 as minimum and maximum grade respectively. A "cum laude" can be added to the maximum grade as a special distinction.
<b>Additional Requirements</b>	<b>Full-time study mobilities</b> are supposed to last the whole academic year. <b>PLEASE NOTE:</b> The SNS is a selective and demanding institution. A very high standard is required of students. It might prove difficult to obtain 30 ECTS in one semester taking exams only at the Scuola Normale, we suggest semester mobilities only for students needing a limited number of ECTS or wishing to write their final thesis.
<b>Italian Language Courses</b>	
The Scuola Normale Superiore offers to its <b>incoming students</b> the chance to learn and improve their Italian language knowledge through dedicated certified university training. The SNS covers the cost of <b>one course per academic year</b> to those students whose permanence at the Scuola Normale allows them to fully attend classes and to take the final exam
