GPA	Minimum GPA 2.50
Language proficiency test score (e.g. TOEFL, JLPT, HSK)	<p>PU provides English and Chinese taught courses as well as a handful of Japanese taught courses. Students are required to be evaluated of their language proficiency by the home university prior to taking the exchange program.</p> <p>-If exchange students plan to take English taught academic courses, prefer to have TOEFL iTP 500, but it's not mandatory if we have nomination and recommendation from partners.</p> <p>- If exchange students plan to take Chinese academic taught courses: Exchange students need to reach HSK 4-5 or any equivalent level from different proficiency tests.</p> <p>Please note: if students plan to take Chinese language courses, there is no need to provide the language proficiency. PU offers total 9 level of Chinese language course, includes beginner level course.</p>

Note	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students who cancel the dorm reservation after applying will be required to pay the full amount of one-semester dorm fee. 2. The bedding set is only available for students that live in school dorm. The price for a new bedding set will is 3,000 TWD, please do prepare cash and pay upon arrival to the OIA staff. (The bedding set includes pillow, duvet, and bedding sheet) 3. Students who live off-campus apartment will need to prepare the bedding set by themselves. (The off-campus apartment only offers mattress) 	

6. Academic Options:

Exchange students have following three options for course plan. (choose ONE only)

Option 1	1. Chinese language courses for 10 hours per week (10 credits) 2. Regular courses for up to 12 credits
Option 2:	1. Chinese language course for 15 hours per week (15 credits) 2. Regular courses for up to 7 credits
Option 3:	Students can choose any regular courses from any faculties for up to 22 credits.

Note:

1. Credits Limitation:

- Maximum credits for exchange students is 22 credits.
- Minimum credits are 2 or 3 credits because one subject could be 2 or 3 credits.
- Suggested study load: 15-18 credits, exchange students don't have to reach the exact 22 credits.

2. Transcript Delivery:

- General Exchange Students: Transcripts will be mailed to International office of home university within 1.5 months after the end of semester.
- ISEP Exchange Students: PU will send the transcript to ISEP center, then ISEP will dispatch the package to student's home university.

3. Fee-Paying Program (visiting student):

Only option 2 is available for visiting student. The tuition is TWD 54,000/person.

All of the exchange students **must pay** the mandatory fee list as below to complete their enrolment.

Note: One-year program students will need to pay for the Facility's Maintain Fee, Internet Usage Fee and dorm fee(if applicable) in their 2nd semester.

One-year exchange students will pay two times mandatory of Facility's Maintain fee and Internet usage fee in both fall and spring semesters.
