**Admission**

<b>Language requirements</b>	<p>Students are required to have a <b>B2 level in French</b>. <b>Nomination</b>	<p>Before starting the admission procedure, students must have been nominated by their home institution. Nominations must be sent by email to <a href="mailto:International.deg@u-paris.fr">International.deg@u-paris.fr</a>.</p> <p><b>Nomination deadlines:</b></p> <p>First (fall) semester and full academic year : April 30th Second (spring) semester : October 15th</p>
<b>Application</b>	<p>The procedure will be sent by email to the nominated students at the end of the nomination period. A proof of language efficiency will be required.</p> <p><b>Application dealines :</b></p> <p>First (fall) semester and full academic year : May 15th Second (spring) semester : October 30th</p> <p>An admission letter will be issued once the application is validated</p>
